

ACTIVITY 1

MAKE A VEGETABLE ANIMAL

Get creative and make an animal or your own mythical creature using vegetables !

RESOURCES

Potatoes, carrots, or other vegetables of different shapes

Paper plates

Craft materials e.g. feathers, pipe cleaners, stickers, pom poms, googly eyes, etc.

Sticky-tac/or double sided sticky tape

Felt pens/pencil

Cocktail sticks



HOW TO MAKE

1. Choose a vegetable, look at its shape, what kind of animal could it be?
2. Put the vegetable on a paper plate to keep any mess contained
3. Use craft materials to create an animal, adults should help with making holes using end of pencil or scissors
4. Push in pipe cleaners for legs, or tape on feathers for wings.
5. Adults could help fixing parts together with cocktail sticks
6. Use pen or stick on google eyes for face, pom poms for ears or tails, etc.
7. Encourage the child to use their imagination of what the animal might look like
8. Perhaps take a photo or suggest the child write, tell or act out a story about the animal
